

y husband and I both worked at one of our church schools. We also had three children attending the school. Needless to say, our budget was tight.

One year around Christmas time, I realized that one of my students needed financial aid if he was going to continue attending church school. Since my husband was the principal, he was able to raise some funds; but, the child still needed \$250.00 to pay his tuition.

This was on my mind one evening as I was folding clothes. Like a bolt of lightning, I felt God say, "You pay it." "Me! I already pay tuition for three children. Isn't that enough?" We had a very tight budget and no outside source of income. The impression didn't go away. I discussed the situation with my husband, and he agreed that we would pay it, but how?

In January, I went to the mailbox and there was a refund check for \$50. The letter with the check stated that I had overpaid on some window blinds for my home. In February and March, my husband received checks for around \$50 from the fruit company that our school used for fundraising. The company wanted to show their appreciation for his

In April, I heard a report on the news about overpaid state taxes. We filed a claim to see if we had possibly overpaid. We received \$250 in a refund check which was the total amount we needed for the promised tuition!

God not only sent the money, He sent much more. He didn't need us to give the money. He didn't even want us to give the money; He only wanted me to be willing. He supplied the money. What a powerful lesson He taught me—one that changed my life. I saw how faithful God is to us. The blessings flow beyond our wildest expectations when we listen to His still, small voice and are willing to obey.

From this experience, we moved on to educate all three of our daughters, debt free, at Southern Adventist University. God has never failed us. He says, put me to the test and I will show you what I am willing to do for you (Malachi 3:10). Praise God!!!
