




HOW CAN WE BE CERTAIN THAT WE CAN TRUST THE SCRIPTURES?

- EXTERNAL EVIDENCE IS WHAT SOURCES OUTSIDE THE BIBLE SAY ABOUT THE BIBLE

THAT THE MAN OF GOD MAY BE COMPLETE, THOROUGHLY EQUIPPED FOR EVERY GOOD WORK.





HERMENEUTICS

THE METHOD OR METHODS ONE EMPLOYEES IN THE STUDY OF BIBLICAL PASSAGES.

- ✓ The same hermeneutic must be used to prove all doctrines.
- ✓ If we use one hermeneutic to prove one doctrine and a different one to prove another, there will never be a definitive method to settle disputes or to understand potential "new light" that may come along.



A BIBLICAL HERMENEUTIC-ISAIAH 2<u>8:10</u>

- 1. Study as mature Christians.
 - ✓ The previous verse even asks the question, "Whom will He teach knowledge? And whom will He make to understand the message?"
- 2. Demands Intellectual Integrity.
 - ✓ We must be willing to come to the Bible without bias and surrender our thoughts and preconceived notions to the Lord's teaching.
- 3. Context is king.
 - ✓ The fact that we are called to look line upon line mandates that we consider the 3-fold context.

A BIBLICAL HERMENEUTIC-ISAIAH 28:10

- 1. The literary context:
 - ✓ Each verse must be considered within the passage, the chapter, the book, and the Canon.
- 2. The historical context:
 - ✓ The Bible was not written within a vacuum. The events and prophecies of the Bible unfold and have unfolded within the stream of time.
- 3. The cultural context:
 - ✓ We must ask how the people living during the time of writing would have received things.

SCRIPTURES AS THEY READ...





- YET, SOME PEOPLÉ GET UPSET WHEN IT'S APPLIED TO GOD WHEN IT WAS HIS IDEA.





 - ✓ THE HOLY SPIRIT IS SAID TO ALLOW US TO COMMUNE WITH HIM.












GENESIS 1:26, 27 NKJV TAKE NOTE HERE THAT GOD SPEAKS OF HIMSELF IN VERSE 26 IN A PLURAL SENSE ✓ "US MAKE", "OUR IMAGE", "OUR LIKENESS". THEN IN VERSE 27 MOSES ADDRESSES GOD IN A SINGULAR SENSE ✓ "HIS OWN IMAGE", "HE CREATED" THIS IS A VERY STRONG INDICATION THAT MOSES UNDERSTOOD "ECHAD" AND HOW MULTIPLES COME TOGETHER TO FORM ONE.





THE FIRST LESSON THAT CHILDREN ARE TO BE TAUGHT IS THAT GOD IS THEIR FATHER.




THE WORD WAS GOD

- ✓ INDICATES THE TIMELESSNESS OF CHRIST AS GOD
 - If Jesus had a beginning in the sense of being created or begotten; then He could not qualify as being God
 - Because He was God as the Word, Jesus must be given equality with the Father.
 - Being the Creator is another timeless quality of God that is here attributed to Jesus, and we know from Genesis that God created ex nihilo (out of nothing) because of the word bara (בְּרָא).
 - This word is only ever used with God.

THE ONLY BEGOTTEN OF THE FATHER


- ✓ DOES THIS PHRASE MEAN JESUS HAS A BEGINNING?
 - Let's let the Bible answer this for us.
 - The phrase translated here as "only begotten" comes from the Greek word monogenes (μονογενής).
 - This word is actually poorly translated in most translations.
 - The best Greek translations are actually "unique" or "one and only"
 - So getting hung up on the idea that somehow Christ was "begotten" in the sense of having an "original beginning" is not substantiated from the Bible.





THE ONLY BEGOTTEN OF THE FATHER

- ✓ Jesus is begotten only in the sense that He took on humanity.
- ✓ Jesus Is not begotten in the sense that He has a beginning point way back in time eons ago.
- ✓ John I:1 could not be accurate and assert that "the Word Was God" if Jesus has a beginning.
- ✓ To Assert that Jesus has a beginning when the Bible clearly says He is God, is to nullify that Jesus is God at all.
- ✓ God cannot be God and have a beginning or else He ceases to qualify as being God.






THE I AM OF SCRIPTURE

- ✓ This phrase takes our minds back Exodus 3:14.
- ✓ In Exodus 3:14 God tells Moses that He is the "I Am Who I Am" and it is the "I Am" who is calling out the people.
- ✓ The Hebrew phrase that is being translated here is haya asher haya (הָיָה אֲשֶׁר הָיָה).
- ✓ The word haya literally means "to be" or "to exist."
- ✓ So "I Am Who I Am" literally means that "I exist because I exist" or "I Am the Self-existent One."
- ✓ And Jesus says that He is that same "Self-existent God" Who spoke from the burning bush to Moses.
- ✓ Therefore, it is impossible for Jesus to have a beginning!



THE COMING OF THE HELPER

- ✓ NOTE HOW JESUS REFERS TO THE HELPER
 - Jesus uses the pronoun auton (αὐτός) this is the third person, singular, masculine form.
 - This is in harmony with the word translated here as helper, which is panakletas (παράκλητος) which is also in singular masculine noun form.
 - Jesus does not refer to the Helper as being some impersonal force from the Father, but rather He attributes personhood to Him.





- ✓ HE MAKES INTERCESSION FOR US
 - Even our prayers to God would be an offense to Him if we did not have help.
 - The Holy Spirit takes our weak, unworthy prayers and translates them into something beautiful and acceptable to God the Father.
 - This divine intercession is a beautiful gift from God and helps us see just how far the Lord will go in helping us to be saved.




- ✓ HE TEACHES US AND BRINGS TO REMEMBRANCE
 THE THINGS WE HAVE ALREADY LEARNED
 - We cannot learn the things of God without the help of the Holy Spirit. Only God can help us understand who He is.
 - The Holy Spirit touches our minds and helps us recall what we have studied just when we need it.
 - This totally lines up with the idea of the Holy Spirit being the "Helper". Parakletos means the one who comes to another's aid.
 - Notice once again the use of masculine pronouns.



- ✓ HE GRANTS US DISCERNMENT FOR TRUTH
 - Without the help of the Holy Spirit, truth becomes only that which is relevant to our experience.
 - Without His help, we would be lost in a vast sea of opinions and nothing to tell us what is really true.
 Pilate suffered from this problem as does the postmodern world today
 - We read that truth is the Word of God (John 17:17) and now we know that we will not recognize that truth without the help of the Holy Spirit.



- ✓ HE CONVICTS ALL OF SIN, RIGHTEOUSNESS, & JUDGMENT
 - Sin because the world does not believe in Jesus.
 - Righteousness because the world can no longer see a living example of righteousness as displayed in the life of Jesus.
 - Judgment because the everyone needs to know that they will be judged based on to whom they give their allegiance and loyalty, and the "ruler of this world" AKA, Satan, will be judged for his sins.
 - No wonder the devil wants people to reject the Holy Spirit! Why get rid of the Spirit unless you wanted to hide the reality and result of sin?



- ✓ HE GIVES US POWER TO BE WITNESSES FOR JESUS
 - The world desires power, but it's power to rule over others.
 - The Holy Spirit wants to give us power so that do not live in fear and shy away from doing our part to warn a dying world.
 - Notice this counsel from the apostle Paul...





 - So, the Holy Spirit is the One who takes away our fears and gives us the power, love, and self-control to be what God has called us to be!






- ✓ HE SEALS GOD'S FOLLOWERS IN THE TRUTH
 - When something is sealed it is secured from corruption.
 - As it relates to the Word of God and loyalty to the Lord, we need to be sealed from the corruption of deception and error (Rev. 7:3, Matt. 24:4).
 - To be sealed means that we have made a conscience decision about a given idea.



- ✓ HE SANCTIFIES AND JUSTIFIES US
 - Sanctification is not something that happens on its own or by us trying hard enough.
 - Our part is to live a surrendered life so that the Holy Spirit can work within us.
 - Likewise, justification is not something that we can cause to happen on our own.
 - Yes, we have to choose to accept Jesus as our Savior and Lord, but the Holy Spirit is One that gives us that heart to want Jesus in the first place.
